

2016 OSIA Colorado Foundation Scholarship Application

The Order Sons of Italy in America (OSIA) is the largest organization of Americans of Italian descent in the United States and Canada. Their purpose is to unite all people of Italian descent to celebrate the culture and heritage of their ancestral country while celebrating the contributions of Italians to America.

Every year, the Grand Lodge of Colorado and the OSIA Colorado Foundation awards scholarships to deserving students from across the state. Each scholarship is awarded on the basis of leadership and academic achievement. These awards are in the amount of \$1,000 and are applied toward tuition at any accredited community college or university. These awards are open to graduating high school seniors as well as current undergraduate students. Undergraduate students must submit their final high school transcript along with a current college scholarship.

The Order Sons of Italy in America is dedicated to promoting excellence in education. Scholarship recipients will be honored at a luncheon at the Lakewood Country Club on Sunday, June 5, 2016. Recipients must be present. Students unable to attend are not eligible for scholarship awards.

Instructions:

Carefully read the entire application prior to completing.

- Application form must be typed or written neatly in black ink.
- All supporting documents from checklist must be included with this application as one package. Incomplete applications will be disqualified.
- Applications must be postmarked no later than April 15, 2016.

Eligibility

- 1. US citizen of Italian descent (at least one parent or grandparent).
- 2. Enrolled in an accredited two or four year college or university or as in incoming freshman.
- 3. Must be enrolled in an accredited two or four year college or university for the 2016-2017 school year.

Requirements Checklist

 1. Official application filled out and returned to the address listed on front of this application.
 2. Official transcripts from the current academic institution you're attending (seniors) and your current transcript and high school transcript (undergraduates). Transcripts must be stamped with the official school mark, unsealed and attached to your application. <u>Transcripts must be included with your application</u> .
 _ 3. Two letters of recommendation from teachers, professors or other academic administrators.
 4. A resume detailing your extra curricular activities, work experience, academic achievements and community involvement.
5. A one page typed reflection on how you identify with or celebrate your Italian Heritage.

Deadline

The deadline for all application and material is **Saturday**, **April 15**, **2016**. All scholarship winners will be notified by email. Previous scholarship recipients are ineligible.
